- 1. Article 4, Directors, Section 4.01, Qualifications, of the Bylaws shall be amended to read as follows:
 - 4.01 Qualification. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors composed of five (5) persons, all of whom shall be members of the Association, serving two (2) year staggered terms of office. with the annual meeting and election in November 2004, there will be a seven (7) person Board with staggered terms of office.
